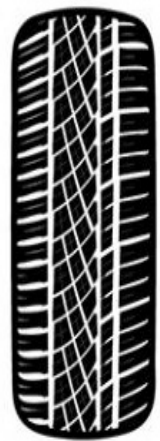

Warmer weather is coming, time to start checking your tires for inflation and wear. Heat can have a huge effect on your tires. The air pressure in tires increases as the temperature goes up. Scientists have figured out that for every 10 degrees (Fahrenheit) that the temperature rises the tire pressure will increase by one pound per square inch (PSI).

Safety action of the week – Bloodborne Pathogens Kit

We live in a crazy world and get the opportunity to see a lot of the craziness with our own eyes daily. In our line work, guest service and dealing with the public, we see people from all walks of life and from time to time we have an unexpected mess to clean up.

In each of your stores you should have a bloodborne pathogens kit hanging on the wall. This kit is to be used for the safe cleaning of blood or bodily fluid spills. This kit contains the necessary items to keep you safe and eliminate the mess.

The kits contents include:

- Absorbent Powder
- Antiseptic Towelette
- Biohazard Bag
- Nitrile Exam Gloves
- Eye & Face Shield Mask
- Large Control Gown
- CPR Breathing Barrier
- Paper towels
- Scoop & Spatula
- Unmarked bag



If you encounter a situation where you need to use this kit, follow these steps:

1. Safety first – your safety is number one priority. Open the kit and put on the gloves, face mask/ eye shield and gown
2. Absorbent powder – sprinkle the powder on the spill and allow a short dwell time
3. Paper towels – layer paper towels on top of spill to control spill and assist the absorbent. After short dwell time, layer fresh towels and wipe away the spill
4. Antiseptic towelette – use the antiseptic towelettes to sterilize the area
5. Red biohazard bag – place all items used in the red bag including gloves, face mask and gown. Place included tie wrap on bag, securing the bag closed and place in dumpster.
6. Wash your hands thoroughly

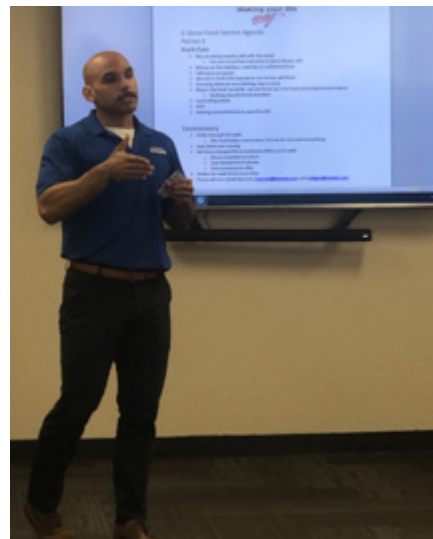
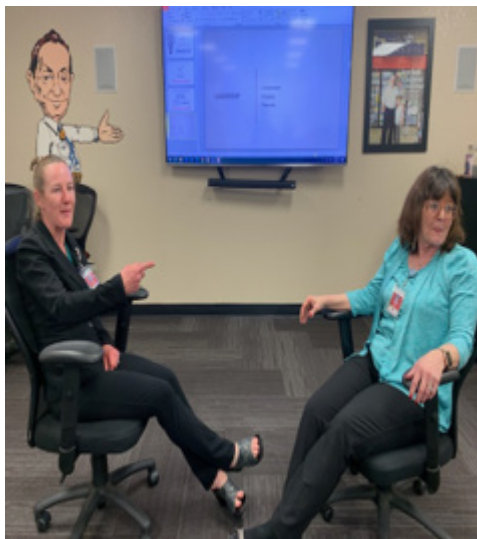
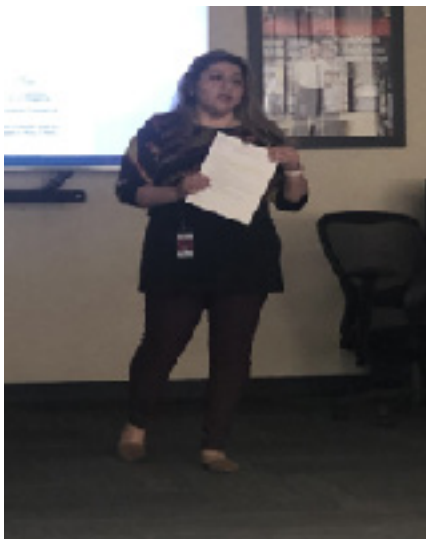


Emma at store 215 continues to sanitize countertops and high touch areas to make sure her Guests and Team Members feel safe. Thank you and keep up the great work, Emma.
