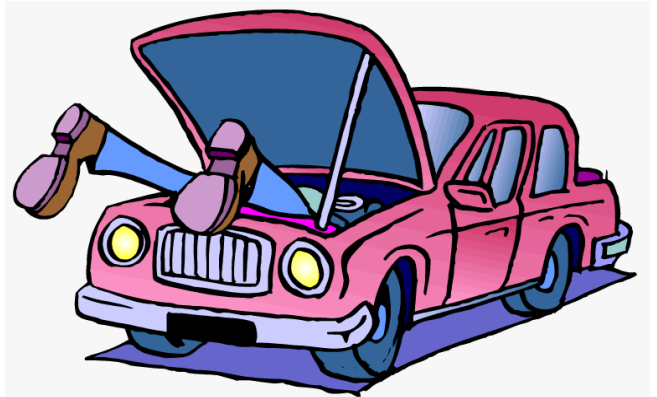

Tips on How to Maintain Your Car

- Check the Engine Oil. Do it regularly—monthly for a vehicle in good condition; more often if you notice an oil leak or find you need to add oil routinely.
- Check Tire Air Pressure. Once a month and before any extended road trips, use an accurate tire-pressure gauge to check the inflation pressure in each tire, including the spare.
- Wash the Car. Try to wash the car every week, if you can. ...
- Other Checks at Each Oil Change. For normal driving, many auto makers recommend changing the engine oil and filter every 7,500 miles or six months, whichever comes first.

For a Business degree plan:

Up to \$9,000 spread over 5 years

This includes a major in a Business area such as management, marketing, accounting, and/or finance.

Maximum Reimbursement - \$3,000 per calendar year:

- Up to 5 courses per calendar year
- \$600 per course for a standard 16 week term, one 7 week term, one 8 week term, or other shortened term.

For a Non-Business degree plan:

Up to \$3,800 spread over 4 years

- 1st and 2nd year -- \$400/semester (Fall and Spring) = \$1,600
- 3rd year -- \$500/semester (Fall and Spring) = \$1,000

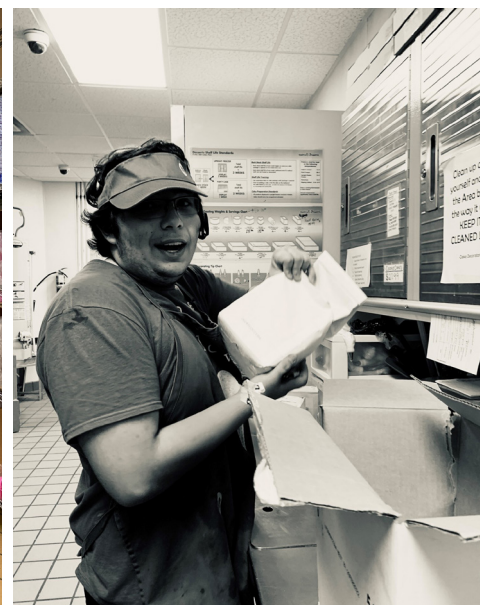

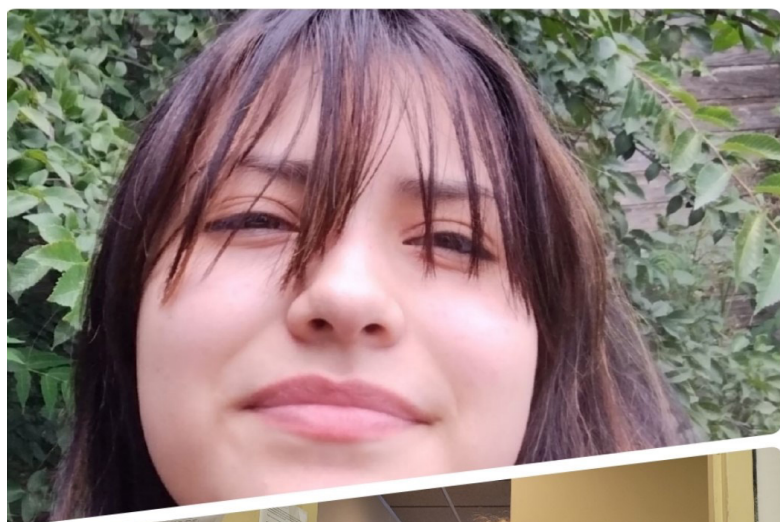
