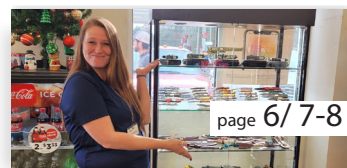

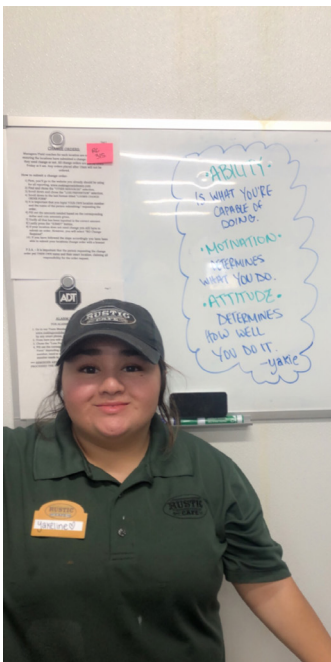

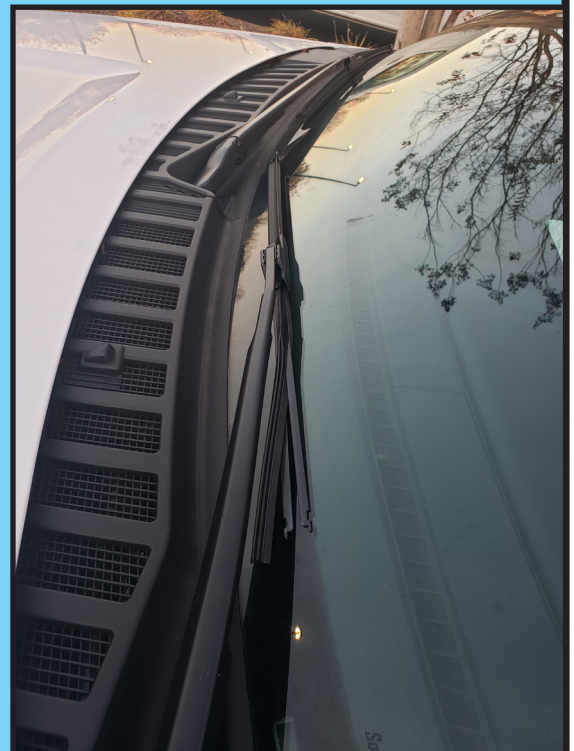
SAFETY NEWS

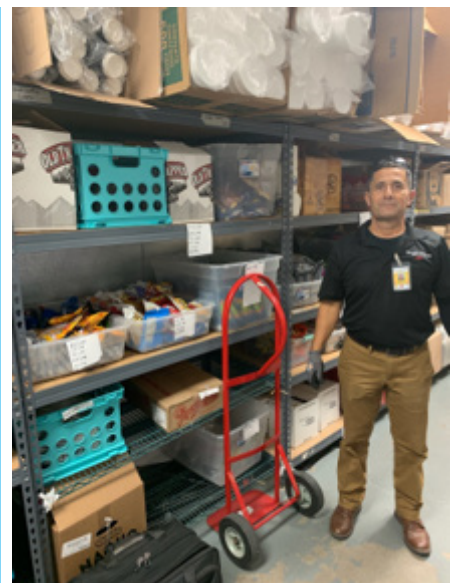

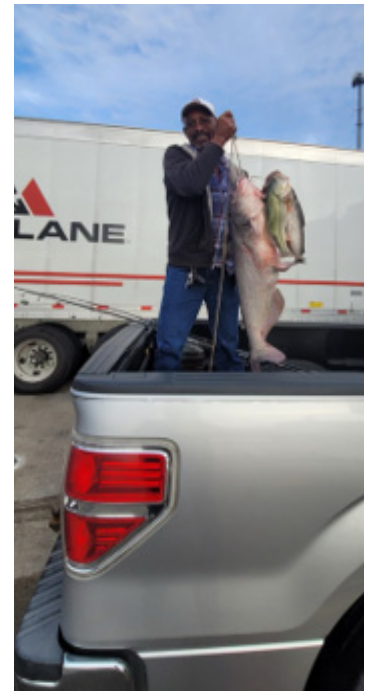
