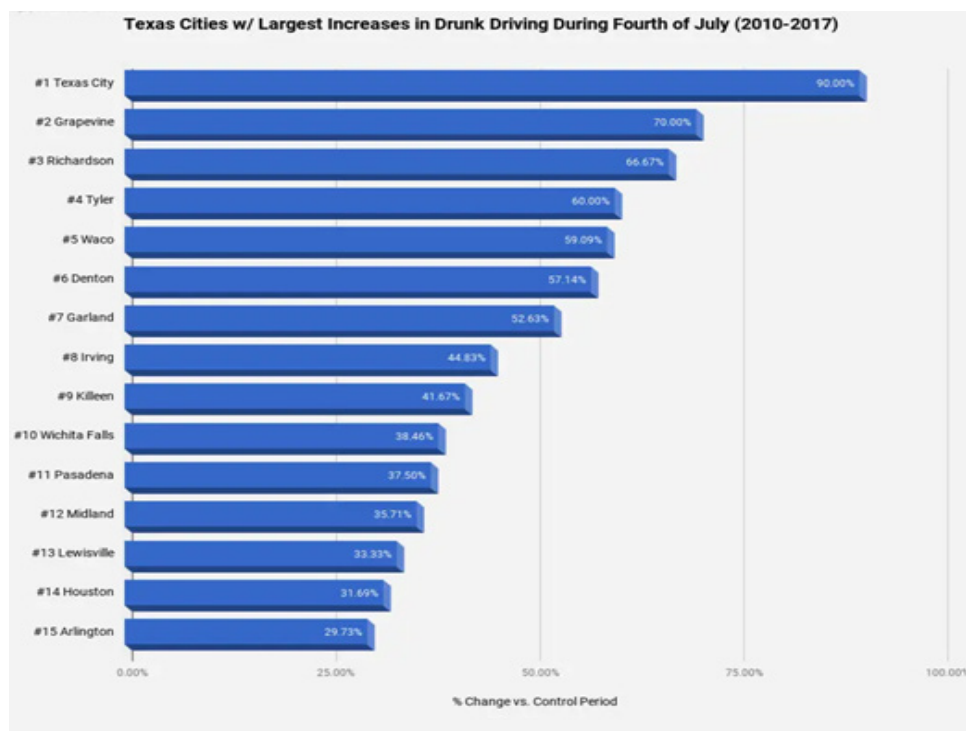
Nothing is too Small!

Drunk Driving is a Significantly Bigger Problem During Holiday Periods

- **34%** increase in total crashes during holiday periods
- **38%** increase in fatalities during holiday periods
- **34%** increase in incapacitating injuries during holiday periods

These numbers are based on a comparison of crashes that occur during holiday periods with crashes that occur during non-holiday periods

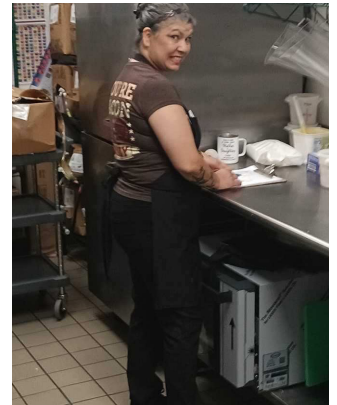

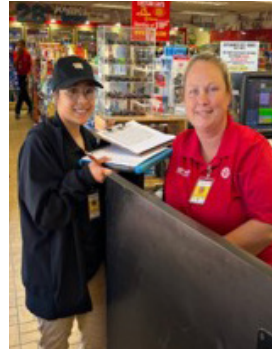

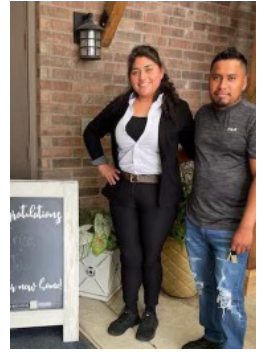
