Keeping Safety in Sight

Nothing is too Small!

Safety Definition: to ensure safe and healthful working conditions for workers by setting and enforcing standards by providing training, outreach, education, and assistance.

Each week during our orientation class we go over what is called a PPE Assessment. The assessment asked for the Job Task. What job are you working on: cleaning the restroom, the fuel dispensers, stocking the cooler, washing cars, cleaning the deep fryer, etc., etc., etc.?

When performing that job function have you ever thought about the Hazards? Restrooms, oh my what could be in them? The fuel dispensers, what chemical are you using? Stocking the cooler, does it get cold? Do you get wet when washing cars? What are the hazards around the deep fryer in Food Service, none to speak of right?

With those Hazards what are some of the PPE Required or needed to perform those tasks more safely?

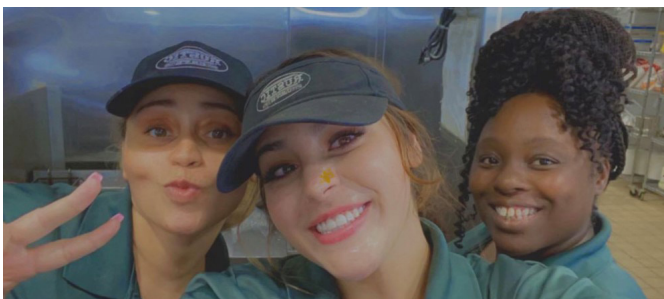

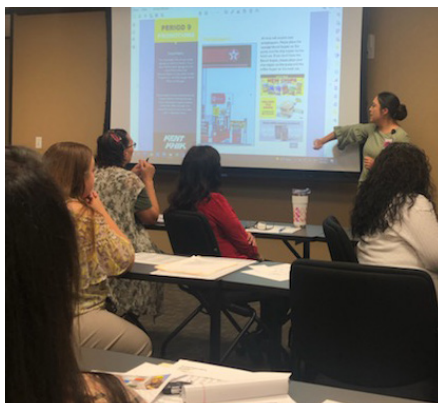
