Keeping Safety in Sight

Nothing is too Small!

Safety Definition: to ensure safe and healthful working conditions for workers by setting and enforcing standards by providing training, outreach, education, and assistance.

Recently it has come to our attention that many of our Team Members walk to work, for a variety of reasons. If you are one of them please reach out to your supervisor and/or the safety department there may be something we can do to help you.

If you know of someone walking to work please reach out to your supervisor and/or the safety department as some people may not be comfortable reaching out on their own.

At the very least consider wearing a safety vest, especially if you are walking while it is dark.

Please be safe and consider following the tips below, it could save your life!

7 Walking Safety Tips

1. Follow the rules of the road and obey signs and signals.
2. Walk on sidewalks whenever they are available.
3. If there is no sidewalk, walk facing traffic and as far from traffic as possible.
4. Cross streets at crosswalks or intersections. Look for cars in all directions, including those turning left or right.
5. If a crosswalk or intersection is not available, locate a well-lit area where you have the best view of traffic. Wait for a gap in traffic that allows enough time to cross safely; continue watching for traffic as you cross.
6. Watch for cars entering or exiting driveways, or backing up in parking lots.
7. Embrace walking as a healthy form of transportation - get up, get out, and get moving.

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY TIPS

Keep your eyes up , and your phone down.		Wear bright-colored clothing or reflective gear if walking at night.	
Look left, right and left again before crossing the street.		Make eye contact with drivers before crossing the street.	
Always walk on sidewalks. If there are no sidewalks, walk facing traffic as far to the left as possible.		Do not run or dart out into the street or cross between parked cars.
