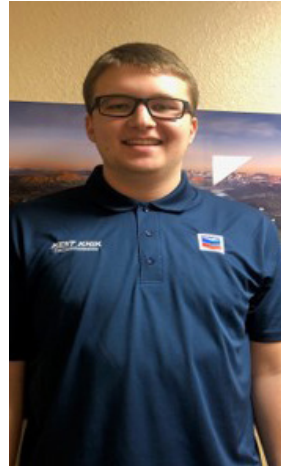

Keeping Safety in Sight

Nothing is too Small!

HEAT STRESS INJURIES

HEAT RASH • Red raised rash • Impairs sweating and decreases effectiveness of sweating	HEAT CRAMPS • Muscle cramps, pain or spasms in the abdomen, arms or legs
HEAT EXHAUSTION • Moist, clammy skin • Dilated pupils • Normal or subnormal temperature • Dizziness, confusion and/or nausea • Weak pulse • Rapid breathing	HEAT STROKE • Dry, red, hot skin • Pupils constricted • Very high body temperature • Dizziness, confusion and/or nausea • Pulse rapid • Unconsciousness • Coma • Death

HOW TO PREVENT

- Hydrate. Drink 8 to 16 cups of water a day.
- Eat a well-balanced diet. Salt food to taste.
- Get plenty of rest, at least 6 hours every 24 hour period.
- Keep a lookout for shipmates and watch for symptoms.
- Limit how much coffee and sodas you drink.

Safety Definition: to ensure safe and healthful working conditions for workers by setting and enforcing standards by providing training, outreach, education, and assistance.

SAFETY TIP OF THE WEEK:

In case you haven't noticed it has gotten hot out. Stay hydrated and be on the lookout for common signs of heat stress. Drink extra water and if you're working outside take breaks to spend time in the shade.

The graphic on the left points out some of the common signs of heat stress. Be sure to monitor yourself but also watch out for your fellow shipmates! Know the signs and work together to stay safe.
