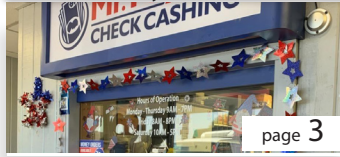

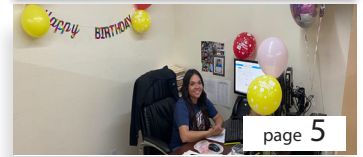

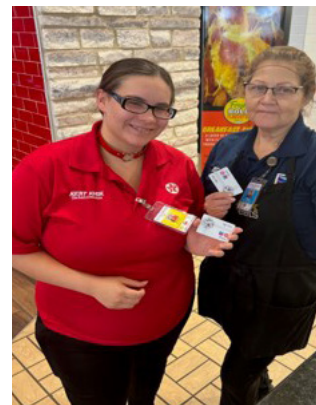

We got a visit from some very special Heroes at store 440!



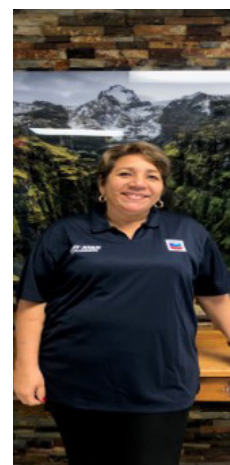
A big thank you to our superheroes Allison and Maria, for acting quick and properly to extinguish a small mulch fire at store 322. Thank you, Team, we appreciate you!

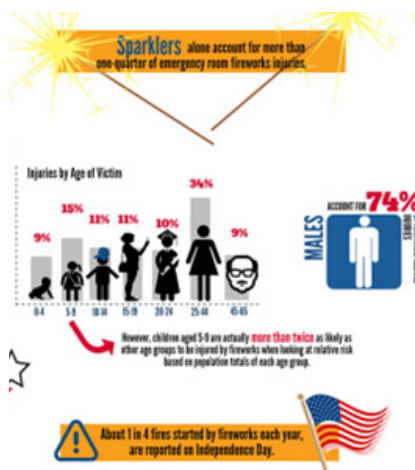
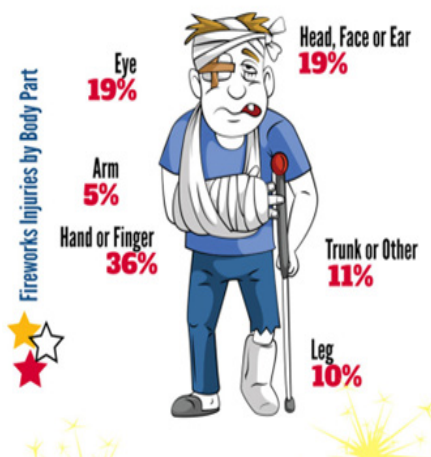
