SAFETY NEWS

Keeping Safety in Sight

Nothing is too Small!

Safety Definition: to ensure safe and healthful working conditions for workers by setting and enforcing standards by providing training, outreach, education, and assistance.

There's two main things to think about when stacking product.

- 1) Do not make stacks too tall. Not only is this dangerous, it makes a lot of work for you later when you need something from the bottom of the pile.
- 2) Never stack anything in front of electrical panels.

We know there isn't always a lot of space to put product, but improper stacking can lead to dangerous situations, damaged products, and people getting injured. When pulling product from a stack, always remove from the top down, include nearby stacks even if they do not appear to be supported by the product you need. Do not try and play Jenga with a case of coke. If you see improper stacking and need help fixing it send an email to safety@kentoil.com and we will help you get it under control.
