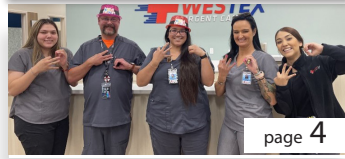

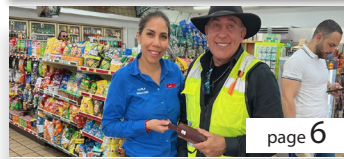

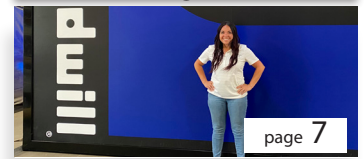

- On school property, unless using a "hands-free" device or the vehicle is stopped. **(TRC 545.4252)**
 - School property includes public elementary, middle, junior high or high school for which a local authority has designated a school crossing zone, during the time a reduced speed limit is in effect.

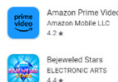

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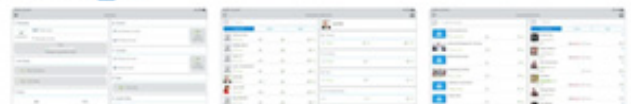

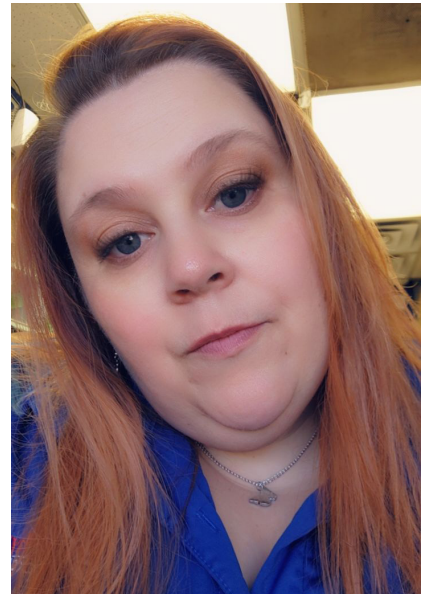
