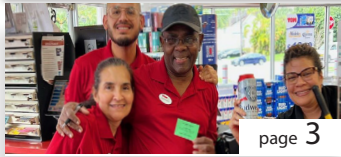

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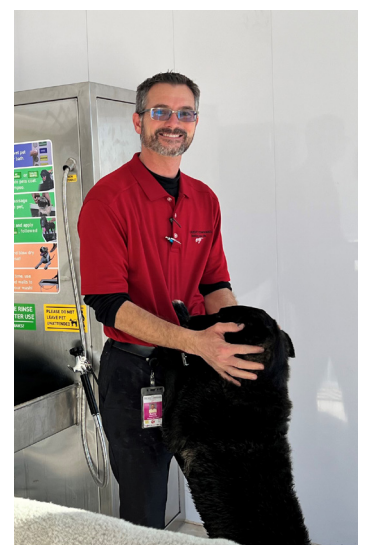

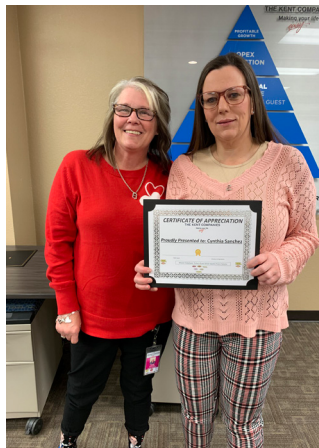
Samantha is now officially the manager for 319! Congratulations, Samantha.

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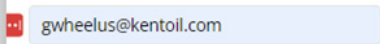

MR. PAYROLL NEWS



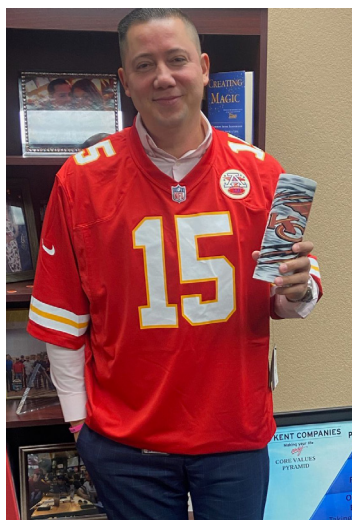
