The Kent Companies have provided all entities with safety box cutters.

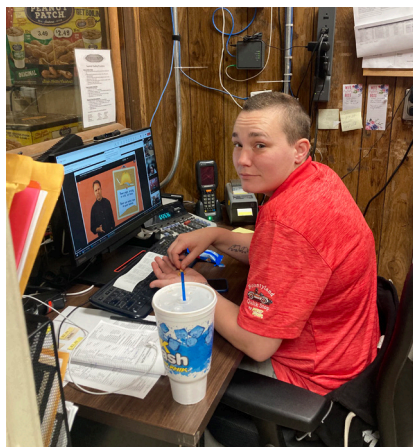
