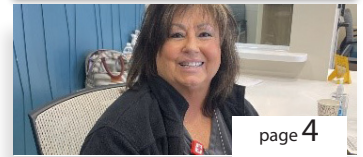

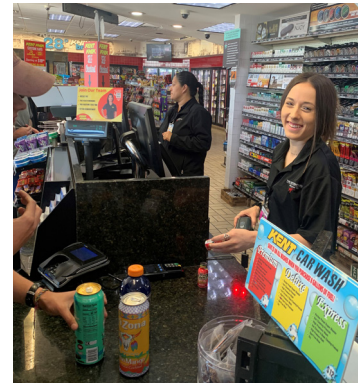

Renee, DOFI, Spotlight



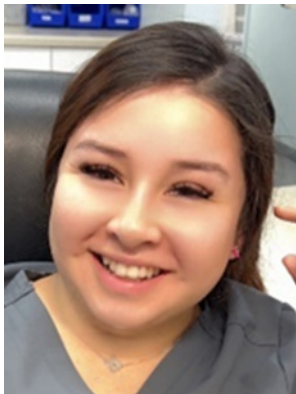
