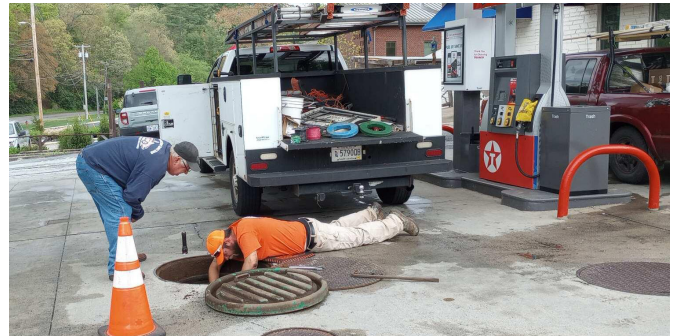
Here's a little poem for all the mothers on our Team. God created something special when he created mothers. I hope each and every one of you had a wonderful day.
