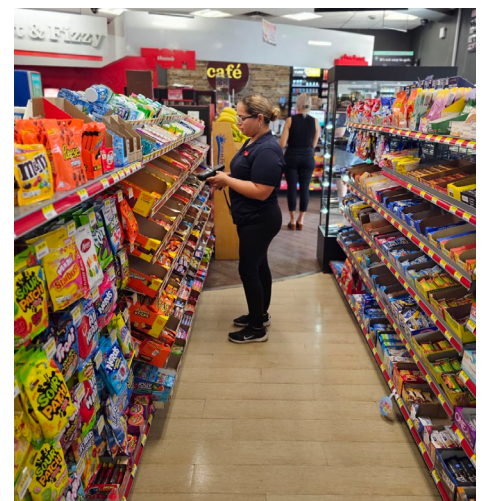

Monica's commitment to patient care and her exemplary performance have made her a valuable asset to our team, and we look forward to her continued contributions in this new capacity. We are so proud of you!

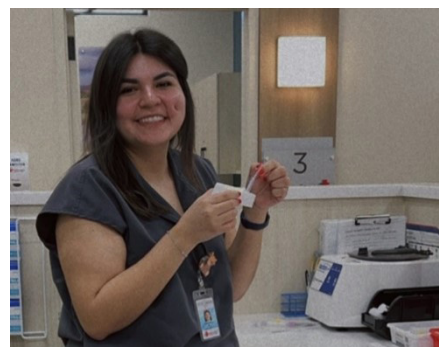
Nallely Spotlight

WestTex Urgent Care is pleased to share another smiling, hard-working Medical Assistant with our guests!

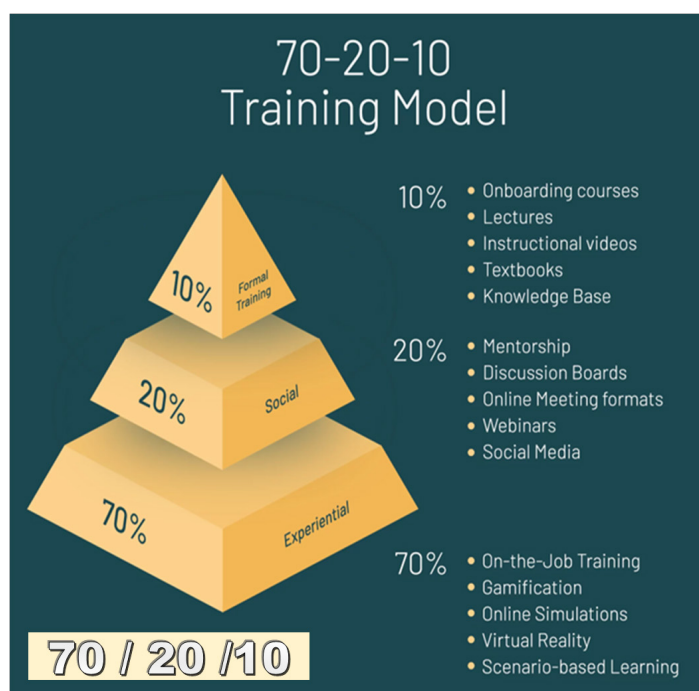
