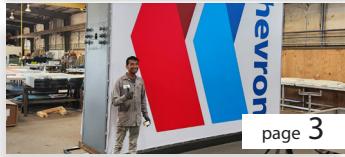

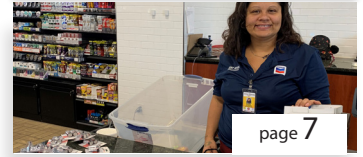

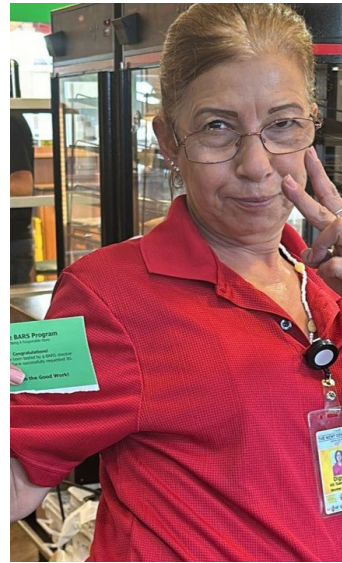


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TOM THUMB NEWS

Juan Carlos Zepeda and Lidia Garcia completing ServSafe training in some cramped conditions. Great job getting it done no matter what.

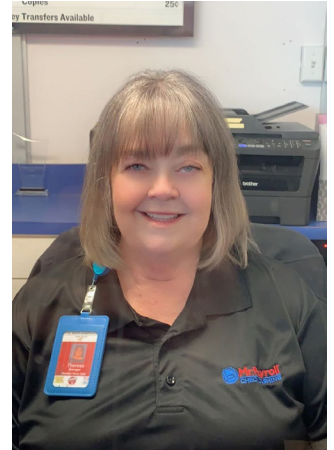

Congestion at locations popular with tourist and travellers is also something commonly faced in the summer months.

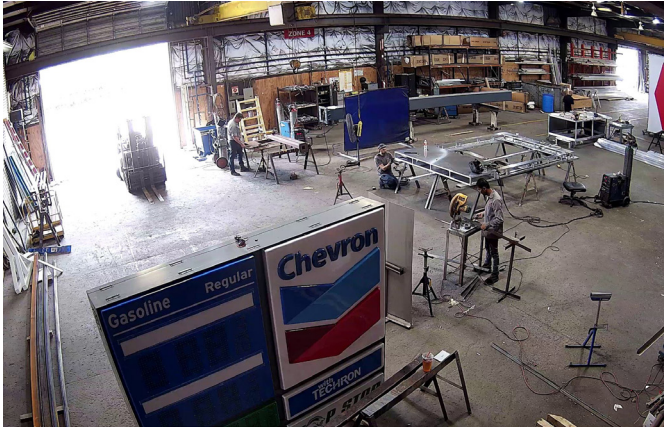


DROWSINESS
