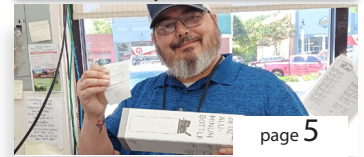
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KENT KWIK NEWS

SAFETY NEWS

Keeping Safety in Sight

Nothing is too Small!

Safety Definition: to ensure safe and healthful working conditions for Team Members by setting and enforcing standards by providing training, outreach, education, and assistance.

This week's topic is all about electrical panels. In keeping those walkways clear we need to do a better job of keeping clutter from in front of the electrical panels.

Working space. The minimum clear working space in front of electric equipment such as switchboards, control panels, switches, circuit breakers, motor controllers, relays, and similar equipment shall not be less than specified in Table K-2 unless otherwise specified in this subpart. Distances shall be measured from the live parts if they are exposed, or from the enclosure front or opening if the live parts are enclosed.

Table K-2 shows that we fall under the 36" or 3 Feet rule as most of our locations do not have more than 2500 Volts entering the building.

Please begin to clean up in front of those electrical panels.

We do a really excellent job at keeping our locations safe but, there is always room to do better. The little things are what separate us from the others out there. Thanks for always Keeping Safety in Sight and remembering Nothing is Too Small.

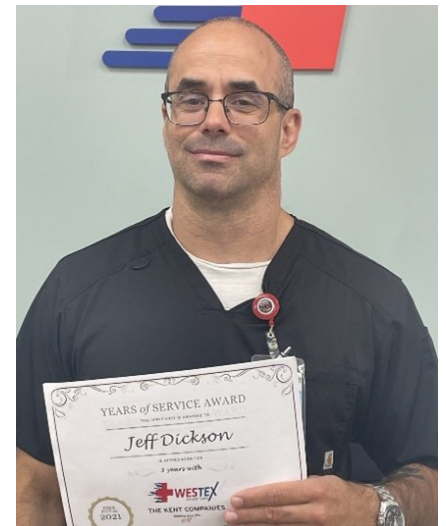

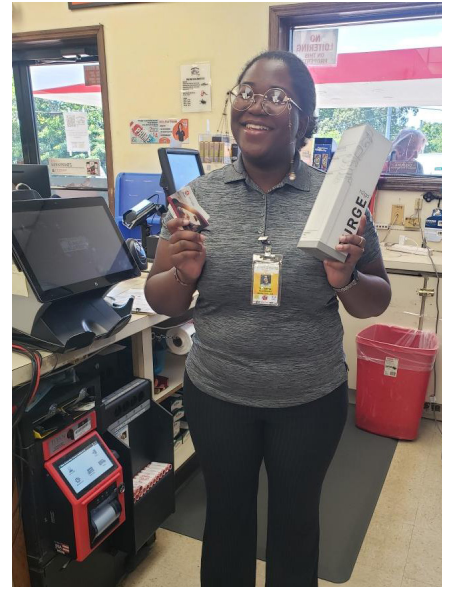
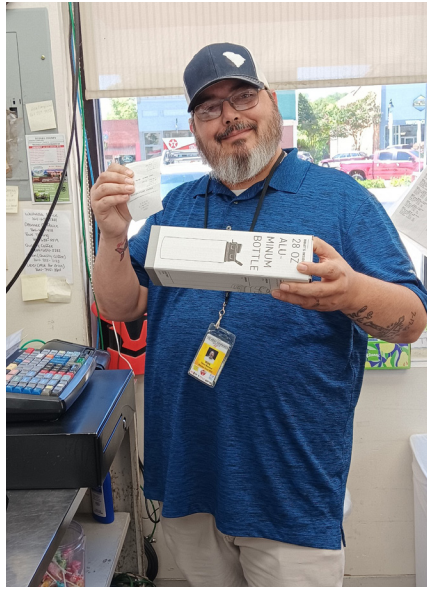
We also want to wish a happy birthday to Ms. Nell, our OG of Mr. Payroll, born on the 4th of July. We hope you enjoyed your day.
