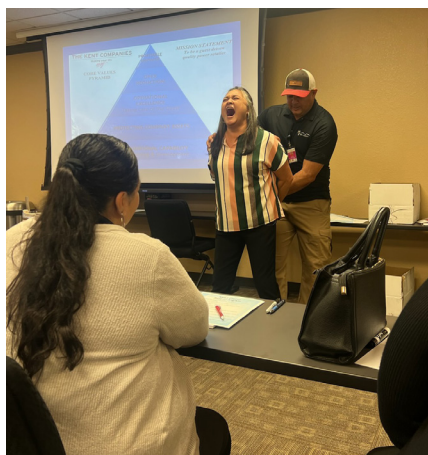
Sampling our new kolaches to hungry Guests at 320 and 326! Everyone is loving the new product and we are excited to expand our breakfast options.

Petra, 351 Store Manager, making sure we are always Guest ready!



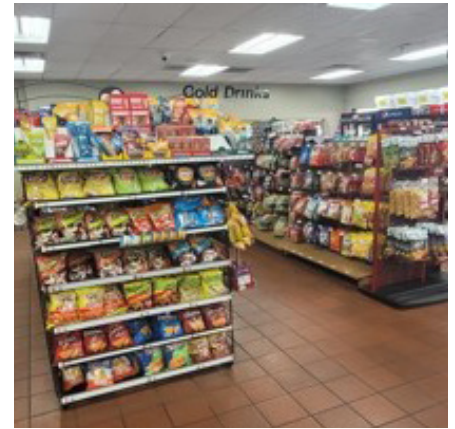
