Happy birthday, Rosemary, from 411. She has been with the Kent Family for over 20 years! Thank you for your hard work and dedication, we look forward to many more years to come.



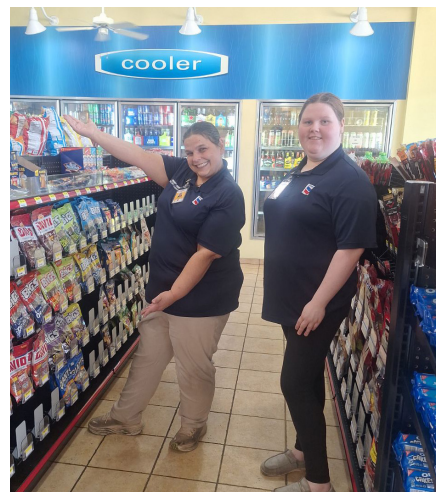

Open Enrollment is quickly approaching! This year open enrollment for The 2025 Benefits will be held the whole month of November. November 1st- November 30th.

What is open enrollment?

Open enrollment is a once-a-year opportunity where everyone who is eligible for benefits can enroll or make changes to all benefit plans.

What benefits are offered, you ask?

We offer medical, dental, vision, supplemental, 401K, and FREE \$50,000 Life Insurance.

Do I need to re-enroll if I currently have benefits?

Yes, due to changes in the upcoming year, all team members will need to re-enroll. If you fail to enroll during open enrollment, benefits will be terminated 12/31/2024.
