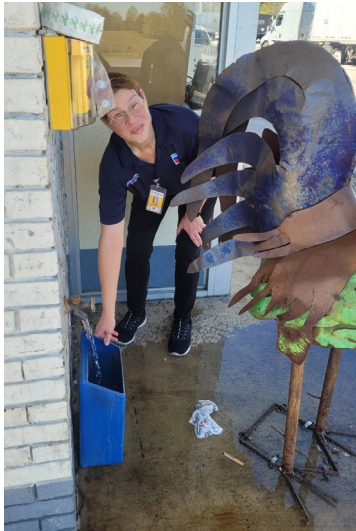

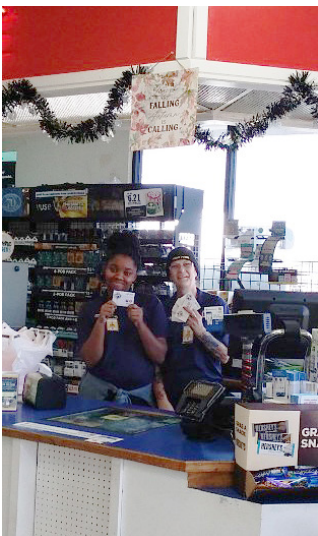

What is open enrollment?

Open enrollment is a once-a-year opportunity where everyone who is eligible for benefits can enroll or make changes to all benefit plans.

What benefits are offered?

We offer medical, dental, vision, supplemental, 401K, and FREE \$50,000 Life Insurance.

Do I need to re-enroll if I currently have benefits?

Yes, due to changes in the upcoming year, all team members will need to re-enroll. If you fail to enroll during open enrollment, benefits will be terminated 12/31/2024.

Keeping Safety in Sight

Nothing is too Small!

Safety Definition: to ensure safe and healthful working conditions for workers by setting and enforcing standards by providing training, outreach, education, and assistance.

Hold a flashlight while trick-or-treating to help you see and others see you. WALK and don't run from house to house.

Always test make-up in a small area first. Remove it before bedtime to prevent possible skin and eye irritation.

Look both ways before crossing the street. Use crosswalks wherever possible.

Over your risk for serious eye injury by not wearing decorative contact lenses.

Walk on sidewalks whenever possible, or on the far edge of the road facing traffic to stay safe.

Eat only factory-wrapped treats. Avoid eating homemade treats made by strangers.

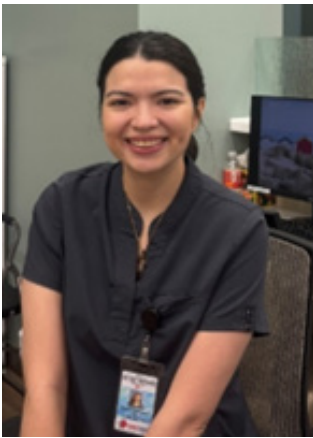
Never enter homes only if you're with a trusted adult. Only visit well-lit houses. Never accept rides from strangers.

Spotlighting Nakaris Fuenmayor, WesTex Urgent Care Medical Assistant



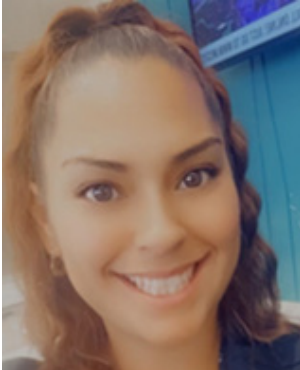

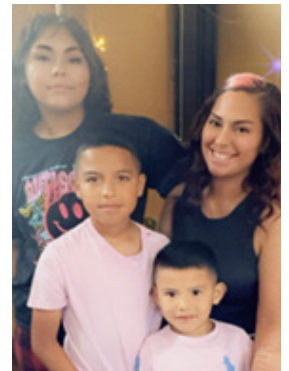
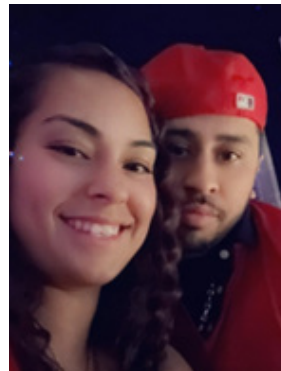
Spotlighting Kristal Villa, WesTex Urgent Care Director of First Impressions
