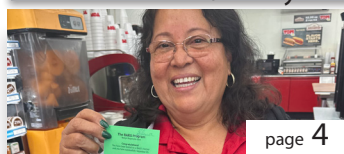

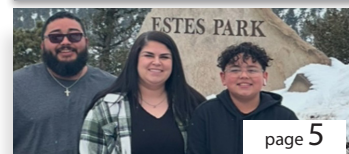

SAFETY NEWS



Here are winter safety tips to prevent slips, trips and falls:

- Wear footwear with slip-resistant soles.
- Walk slowly and take small steps. (Walk like a Penguin)
- Use special care when getting in and out of vehicles.
- Avoid carrying items that block your view of the ground.
- Scan the path six or more feet ahead for hazards.
- Use your vehicle for support when entering or exiting.
- Plan ahead and allow sufficient time to reach your destination.
- If you slip, avoid using your arms to break your fall; tuck your chin to protect your head.
- Wipe your feet thoroughly when entering a building to remove snow and water.
- Watch for black ice by tapping your foot on slick areas to check for safety.
