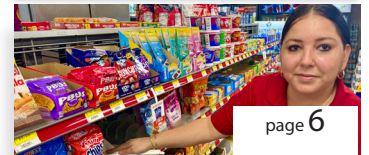

Lezley, who has been with us since February, is on her path to becoming an Assistant Manager.

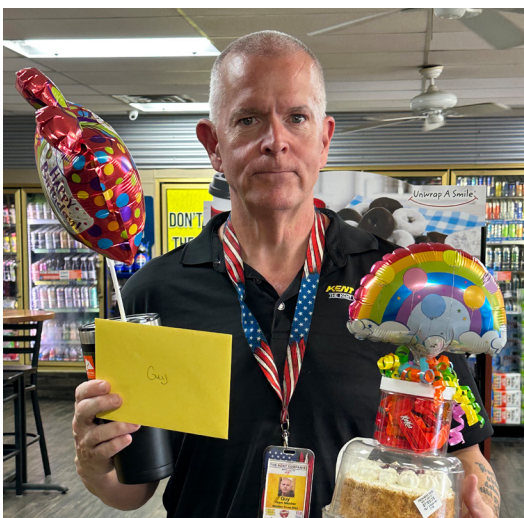
We are thrilled to witness the growth of both Laurie and Lezley within the company! Thank you both for all your hard work!

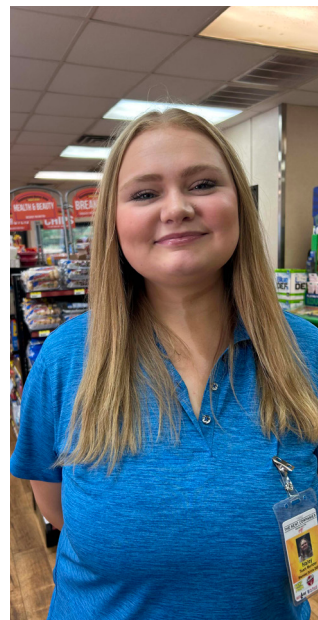

## Meet Marcie, 9107's new Director of First Impressions!

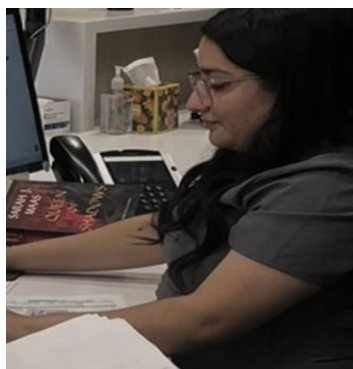
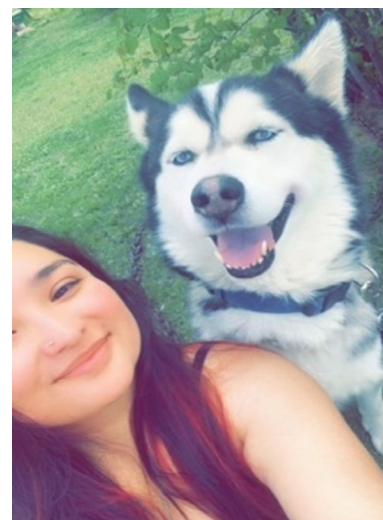

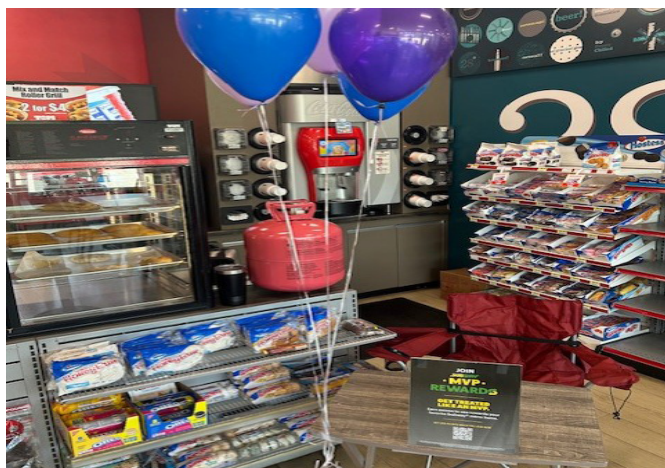
