We would like to thank Bo for the one-on-one training he provided in Fort Stockton this week.

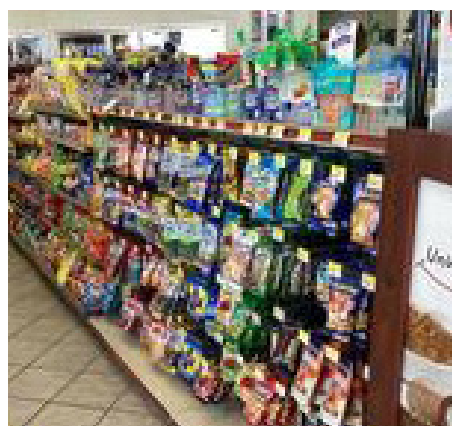
