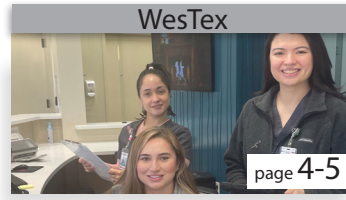

The city of Andrews has been very supportive of us and we're happy to bring more of our businesses to their community.

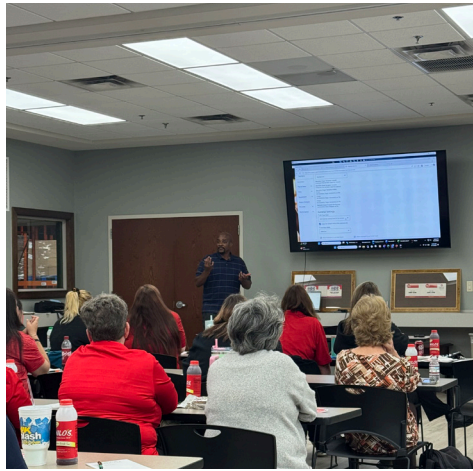
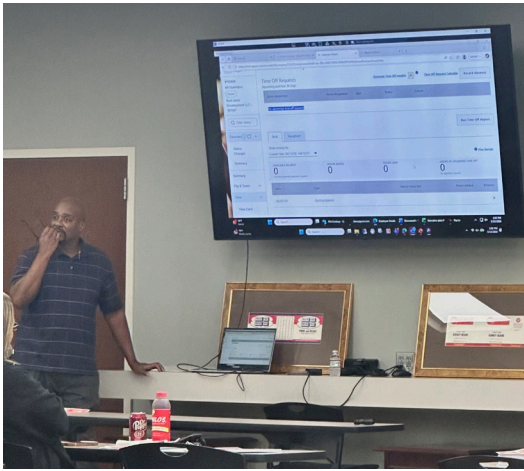
