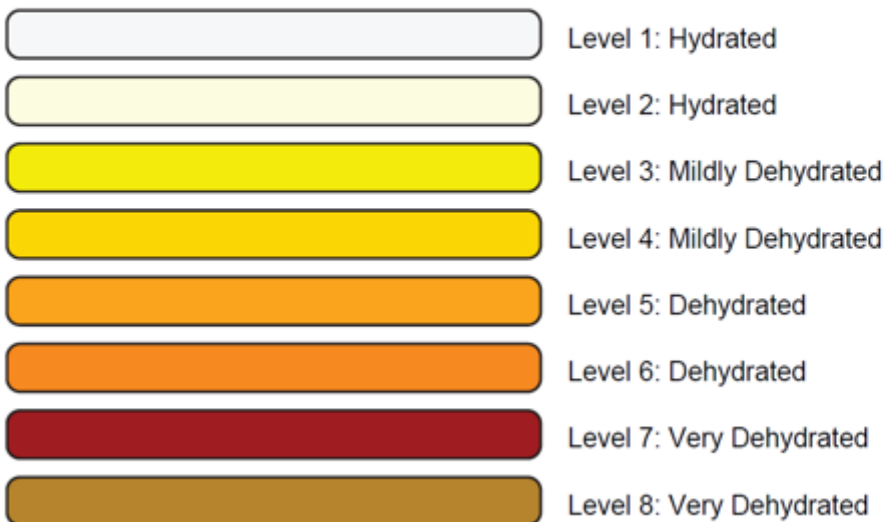

Carl was promoted to Manager at 126.

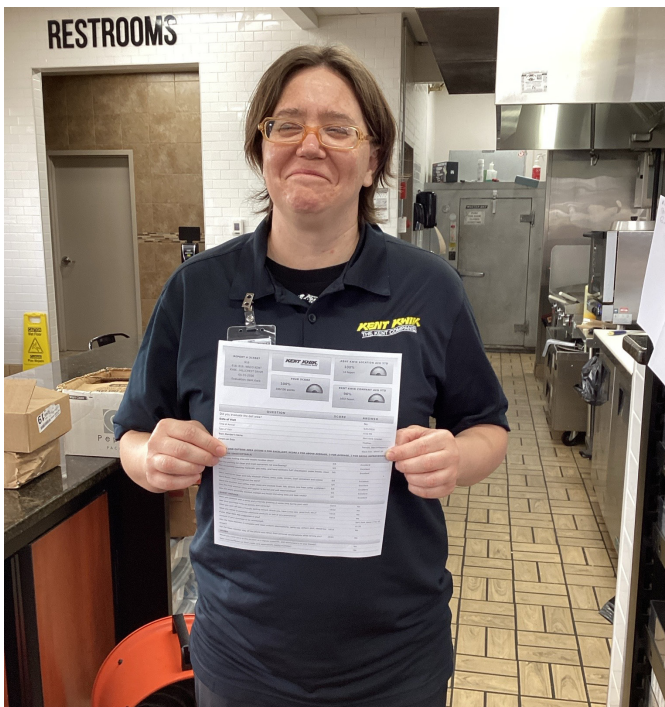

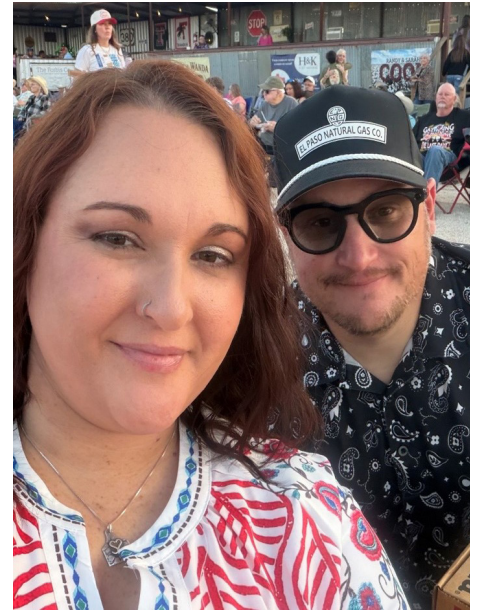
