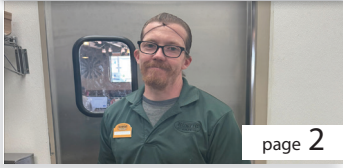

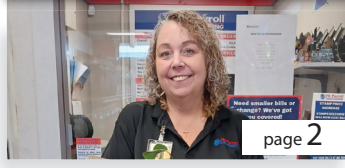

**ALCOHOL + HEAT =
increased risk of
Heatstroke & Dehydration**

Alcohol use can significantly contribute to an increased risk of **heat-related illness**. Hot days can lead to fluid loss through sweat. Drinking alcohol, in combination with high temperatures, means your body may not be able to regulate its own temperature effectively.

HEAT ILLNESS presents itself in 3 phases:
Heat cramps Heat exhaustion Heat stroke

*Don't "drink like a fish" when temps rise!
"Scale back" and make smart decisions!*

As the 4th of July approaches, it's a great time to celebrate with family, friends, cookouts, and fireworks—but don't forget to take care of yourself in the summer heat. High temperatures combined with alcohol can significantly increase the risk of dehydration and heat-related illnesses. Alcohol causes fluid loss and can make it harder for your body to regulate its temperature, especially during long hours outdoors. Heat cramps, heat exhaustion, and heat stroke are all serious conditions that can develop quickly when hydration is neglected. Whether you're working outside, spending the day at the lake, or enjoying a backyard barbecue, make water your best friend. Drink plenty of fluids throughout the day, take breaks in shaded or cool areas, and pay attention to signs of heat stress such as dizziness, headaches, fatigue, or nausea. If you choose to drink alcohol, alternate with water and know your limits. Celebrate safely, make smart decisions, and drink some damn water along the way. Keep Safety in Sight.

Thank you to everyone involved for the hard work, teamwork, and dedication that helped make this opening a success. The results speak for themselves, and we're off to a great start.



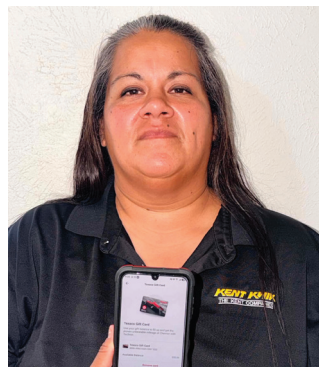
Today we celebrated Toni's birthday at Store 462. She turned 21 again *wink wink*!

Happy birthday to the Store Leader at 980. We hope you had a great day!

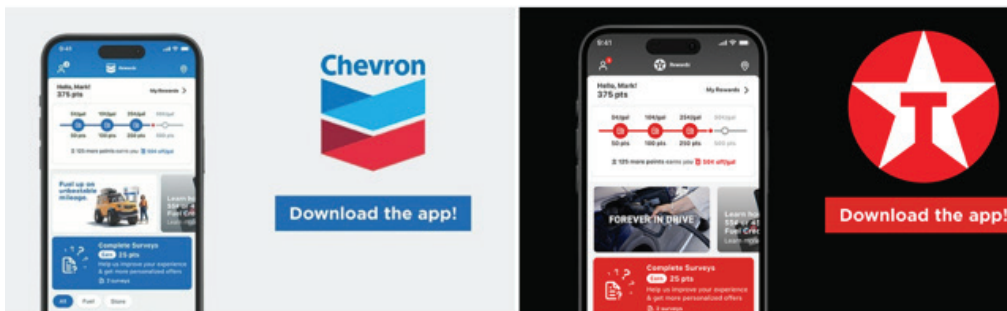

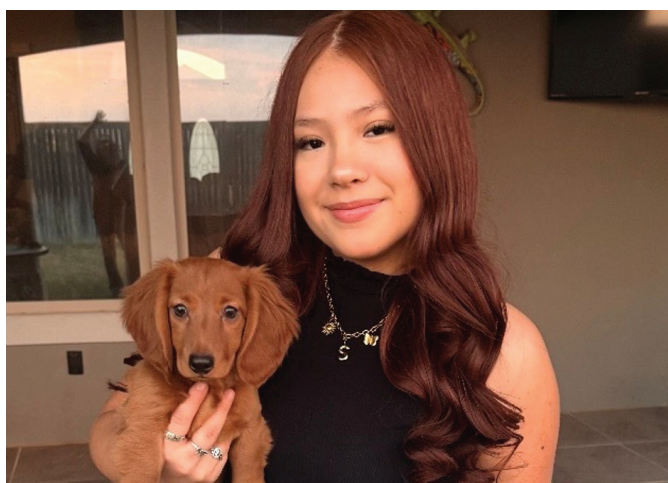
