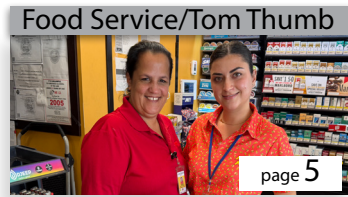

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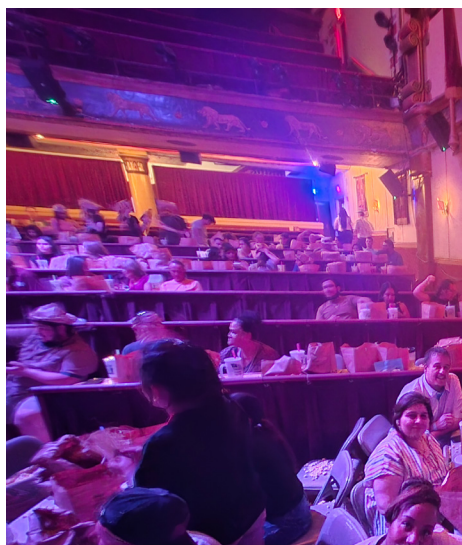
HQ NEWS

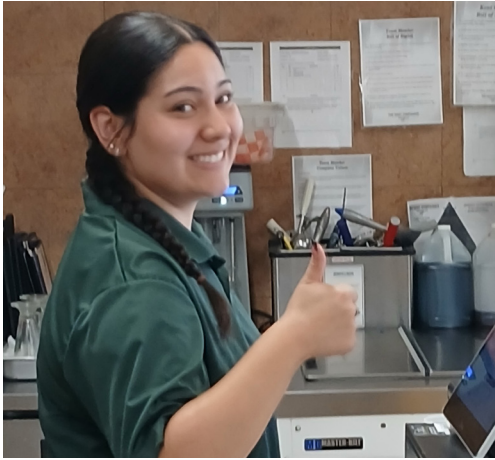
Luis, you leave Kent better than you found us.
